1. Cooks must prepare a minimum of 6 servings of salmon dish for tasting at the Cook-Off. The dish may be prepared at your restaurant, home or place of business.
2. Cooks must provide written copy of recipe with each entry.
3. Cooks must arrive at the The Reluctant Fisherman Inn at 6:00 pm and bring prepared food for transfer onto provided judging plates.
4. The festival will supply eating utensils, table space and awards. Cooks may inquire about a food heating source if necessary.
5. The decision of the judges shall be final.
